

Dr Mirko Sardelic



Dr Mirko Sardelic is a research associate at the Department for Historical and Social Studies of the Croatian Academy of Sciences and Arts (HAZU). He is currently (2015/16) an honorary postdoctoral research fellow at the Centre for the History of Emotions, based at The University of Western Australia, where he leads a project 'The Role of Emotions in Contacts between Eurasian Cultures'.

He graduated in History and Classics from the University of Zagreb in 2004. He worked in academic publishing as the executive editor for books in history, classics and linguistics for four years before going back to academia. He received his PhD in Medieval History from the University of Zagreb in 2013, and spent much of his research time at Cambridge University and as a visiting Fulbright scholar at Columbia University. He is particularly interested in cross-cultural encounters, especially in relation to emotions and identities.
